Who we are?

NumberX International GmbH (referred to as "NumberX", "we", "us" or "our") is a Data Controller and responsible for your personal data and is registered in Schikanedergasse 2/7, 1040 Vienna, Austria with the company number: FN 538351 v.

What data do we collect?

Type of personal information	Description
Contact Details	Your e-mail address

Contractual information	Details about the products or services we provide to you.
Locational Data	Data we get about where you are, such as may come from your mobile phone or the address where you connect a computer to the internet.
Behavioural Data	Details about how you use our products and services and social media.

Communications	What we learn about you from letters, e-mails and conversations between us.

How do we collect your data?

You directly provide NumberX with most of the data we collect. We collect data and process data when you:

- Register via our website for any of our products or services.
- Voluntarily complete a customer survey or provide feedback on any of our message boards or via e-mail.
- Use or view our website via your browser's cookies.
- Add additional information via our website.

How will we use your data?

NumberX collects your data so that we can:

- Create, administer and manage your account.

How do we store your data?

NumberX strives to securely store your data only within the EU or the European Economic Area (EEA). However, it can also happen that data is transferred outside the EU/EEA. If this happens, NumberX ensures that the data protection complies with the GDPR and that the third country is subject to an adequacy decision of the European Union, Standard Contract Clauses (SCC) or other mechanisms to lawfully transfer data are in place. Any data is always stored for as long as NumberX requires it for processing.

NumberX will keep your data for 10 years after the end of the relationship or upon termination of the contract, unless we are required to keep it longer (for example due to a court order or investigation by law enforcement agencies or regulators).
